'Nopukw' means 'language' in the Kwerba family, and does not distinguish a particular variety. ...

This large language area ... includes people such as the Kaowerabeedj, Aurauweedj, Metaweedj, Murenjerwa, Airmati, Segar, and many others. There are some minor differences in dialect, but these are so slight that the people themselves are not aware

of them,. . .
