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The community known as Vanimo is settled on a point on the western end of the bay known as Angriffs Haven. The settlement appears to consist of a number of small hamlets, the houses of which are grouped in the vicinity of the sacred houses para. Three of these hamlets, named respectively Waparate, Mundō, and Pranghi, were visited.

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Angriffs Haven = Vanimo Cheesman 1941

The Roman Catholic Mission west of Wanimo harbour is also called Vanimo: the two native villages of the western bluff are Wanimo and Worrebu. It was the Germans who made confusion by changing the W into V. It is a pity, for the name Vanimo has no meaning in the native language, while Wanimo means "the place beyond" or "round the corner" and designated the harbour. I was told that both bluffs, east and west, are also known as Wanimo.

It covers the coastal villages from Leitere to the Netherlands New Guinea border, and the Sko language in Netherlands territory belongs to the same / language group. Vanimo and Wutung, the two varieties of speech found in the area, can be regarded with Sko as dialects of a single language. The three vary considerably in vocabulary, but structurally they are one.

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Die Vanimo leben in den drei Dörfern Yako, Waromo und Vanimo am Angriffshaven. Über die Bevölkerungszahl liegen unterschiedliche Schätzungen aus verschiedenen Zeiten vor. NEUHAUSS [1911:134] gibt für 1909 500 Einwohner an, wobei / sich diese Zahl allein auf das Dorf Vanimo zu beziehen scheint. 300 Einwohner schätzt GERSTNER [1938:298] 1938 für das Dorf Vanimo, welche er als größtes dieser Gruppe bezeichnet.

THOMAS [1941:163] gibt als durchschnittliche Größe der Dörfer dieses gebietes 300-400 Einwohner an, nur Yako ist kleiner. Wir dürfen demnach für die Vanimo eine Zahl von maximal 800 Personen als real ansehen. Ihre Sprach ist nichtaustonesisch und gehört zu der oben erwähnten Sprachgruppe. Im Widerspruch hierzu steht allerdings die Meldung eines Anonymus [DKB 1907:203], daß die Vanimo-Sprache neben ihrer Ähnlichkeit mit der von Leitere auch eine solche mit der an der Humboldt-Bai gesprochenen austronesischen Sprache habe. Seine Beobachtung, daß eine Verständigung zwischen Bewohnern beider Gebiete möglich ist, braucht aber diesen Widerspruch nicht zu beinhalten.
